

Upholstered Breuer Replacement Seat and Back Instructions

If you are replacing both your Breuer seats and the backs, <u>Remove the seats AND</u> the backs <u>ATTACH THE BACKS FIRST</u>

<u>Instructions For Attaching New Breuer Backs</u>

- 1. Measure the distance from the top of your existing chair to the floor.
- 2. With no seat and back on frame take a belt or a rope and pull top posts together to 15" between center of screw hole to center of screw hole.
- 3. Hold new back at same distance from top to floor. Center back and attach one screw on left side then one on right side. Attach 2 remaining screws. Note: A little soap on the screw threads is a big help. (Caution: Do not over tighten screws.)

Your new Breuer replacement back is ready to use.

<u>Instructions For Attaching New Breuer Seat</u>

- 1. Place your seat upside down (as shown) on a flat surface (corner of a table). Position your chair frame with the front of the replacement.
- 2. Make very small guide holes in bottom of seat with a nail or drill bit before fastening seat with screws to ensure easier assembly.
- 3. Secure the seat to frame using original four (4) screws. Note: A little soap on the screw threads is a big help (Caution: Do not over tighten screws.)

Your new Breuer replacement seat is ready to use.
